Last year you were among over 1,650 people across Australia who participated in the Journeys Home survey. We really appreciated your participation and invite you again to take part in this important survey.

This time the interview will be a bit shorter – about 40 minutes – and we will give you \$40 again as thanks for your time and participation in the interview.

The main purpose of the second survey is to find out what has happened in your life since we last interviewed you. The questions will ask about your living arrangements, education, employment, relationships and health. (We won't need to re-ask many of the questions in the first interview about life when you were growing up.) Your answers will help our understanding of the needs and experiences of Australians in the field of housing and, once combined with information from other participants, will help all levels of government to provide better services to people who have living and housing challenges.

Participation is entirely voluntary. You can opt out at any time. The information provided by you will be handled in strict confidence and used for research purposes only (except where it is required to be reported by law and/ or there is a risk of harm to yourself or others). Reporting will not identify individual respondents. Neither your answers to the survey questions nor your non-participation in the survey will impact on your Centrelink payments.

Interviews will be held between early March and mid May 2012. A Roy Morgan Research interviewer will contact you in a couple of weeks to arrange an interview at a time and location that suits you. Most interviews will be face-to-face, but telephone interviews are also possible.
